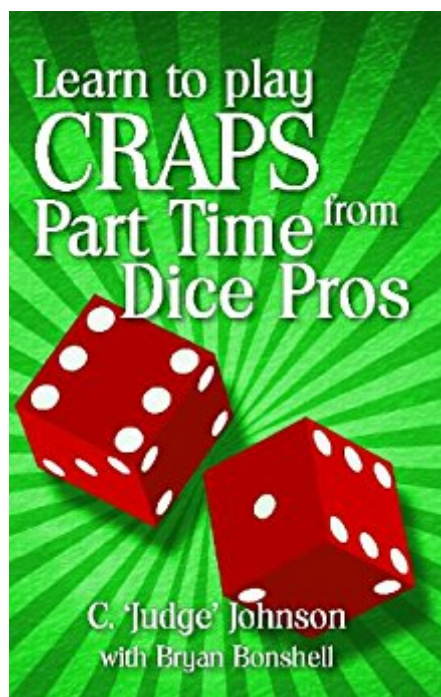

Being a novice to the gambling world, I recently took a trip to Atlantic City to "scope out" the games and learn a little. Craps held my interest for the longest time, simply because it seemed to have the best "bang for your buck" in terms of payout.Before my last trip back to AC, I picked up this book

and can I just say HOLY CRAPS BATMAN! By far, one of the best books to learn the craps game and written in such an easy language that even your 87 year old grandmother will become an expert! This is almost like Craps for Dummies. Its not the normal, dry, boring book on how to win millions. Rather, its about 2 guys that teach you how to make smart bets, hedging your bets, and playing like a profession in no time, with humor! I took the tips I learn from the book and headed straight to Ceasars. While, I didn't win thousands (mainly because i'm a cheap player), I was able to walk away UP over 40% of what i originally started with. The best thing about this books is not just the skills it teaches, it also give the reader real life applications and mistakes made by the authors-- READ: what NOT to do while playing craps! THIS BOOK IS WORTH IT! Get it before your next casino trip!!

I bought this book before my last trip to Vegas. I'd always been interested in playing craps but never had the nerve to give it a shot. I read this book on the plane and I'm REALLY glad I did. There are now two schools of craps play: how to maximize your advantage by calcululating how to

best play against the house and random decisions of the dice, and how to throw the dice in a way to predict a certain outcome. This book tries to explain how to play the game with or without dice controllers shooting. It gives you a lot to think about, but not really enough serious information on how to control dice for several situations. You can argue pro and con about dice control, but in the end, it should have been explained in the book description.

Although basic, dark side play is explained in simpler terms. An additional strategy was added to my game. Enjoyable reading.

I have been fascinated by people playing at the Craps tables in casinos for a long time but I've never learned how to play it. I had one dealer try to explain Craps to me but I was so lost I didn't even try it. This book is great and I found it very easy to read and understand as a beginner. This book is not a get rich quick scam but explains the rules and strategies of playing Craps in detail. The authors really explain everything in a way that is easy to understand and follow. Their method isn't intimidating and full of complicated formulas and math. Their examples of what can happen during the game are excellent and I feel a lot more comfortable with the rules of the game.

This is a fairly quick and easy read. If you're flying from the east coast to vegas you should be able to get the important parts in before touching down at LAS. great book for a beginner, or to have as a quick reference for someone who hasn't played in awhile.

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
