

The book is a pretty good overview of Denmark. It has a wide variety of photos, including small towns, people in local costumes, food, and landscapes. The photos range in size from 4 photos to a page up to 1 photo that spans across 2 pages. The photo quality is above average. Each photo has a description of a few sentences. Overall the book is about 75% photos and about 25% text. Having

seen a number of photo books about Denmark, this is definitely one of the better ones.
